

Walk with us to the cemetery as we pray the rosary for the Holy Souls in purgatory.

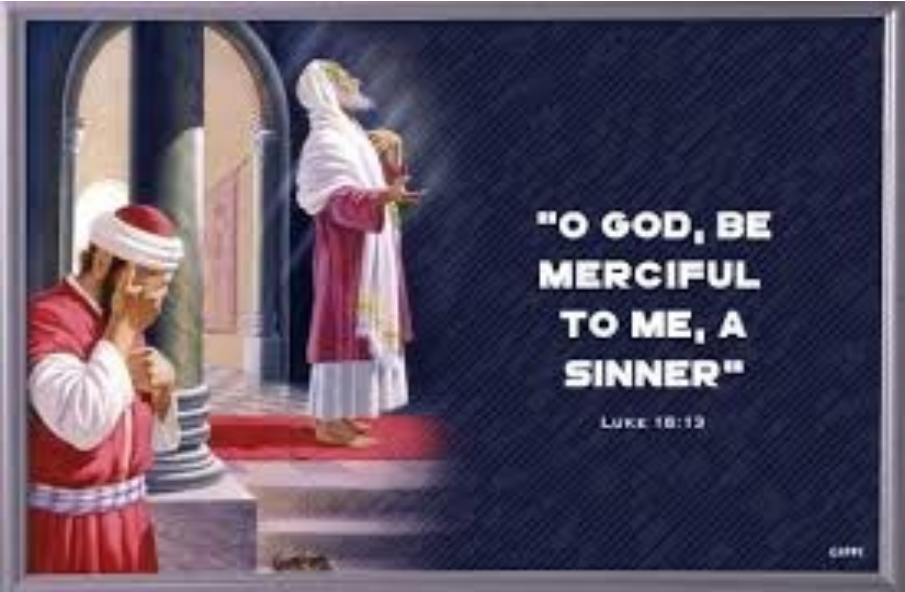
